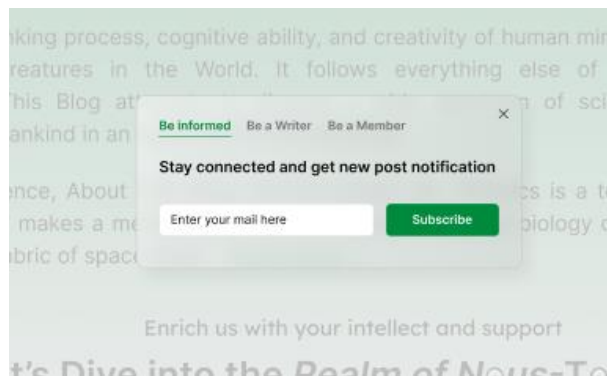


Unification Nous Admin Panel Dynamic Features

Sign-up

Three types of registration process will be there.

1. Be informed - They will register with email, only get notification via email when a new blog comes. Email should have Unsubscribe button.



2. Be a Writer – They will register by Username (should be checked real-time for duplication), email and password. Email verification mail will be send. They can submit the blog to Admin and then Admin will post the blog (same as regular blog post process) by providing Credibility of the writer. So, Admin panel will receive the writing at first in Admin panel.


3. Be a Member – Registration will be done by the same process as Be a Writer. After the registration, Email verification mail will be send. In addition, Paid Member should have PDF version available for downloading any blog. After Sign-up, the visitor will be taken to payment page, then the visitor will select a payment. The registration process will end here from the visitor side. The Admin will manually send invoice to the Paid Member via email and after receiving the payment, Admin will send an email with primary username and password (can be changed later by the Paid member) to the Paid member.

Request an Article

Request process is in three modes.

1. Request an Article
2. Request an Unification
3. Buy an Article (Payment will be collected manually)

For now, anyone can request for an article about any topic (under the 9 categories), and an Auto generated Thank you mail will be send to him. And once the requested Article is posted in the site, a Notification mail will be sent to him. In future only the paid members will be allowed to request for articles.

When a visitor will request an article/unification or buy an article, Admin will see the info in the Admin Panel and then he will contact them manually via email.

Store Page

Admin has a plan to sell his own written ebook from this page. Primarily this option will not be available. This will add in next version of this website. Initially the website will show Under construction message in this page.

Contact Us

When a visitor wants to contact with the Admin and fill-up the form (About the topic, email, details topic), then the Admin has to see them in Admin Panel. Then Admin will contact with them manually.

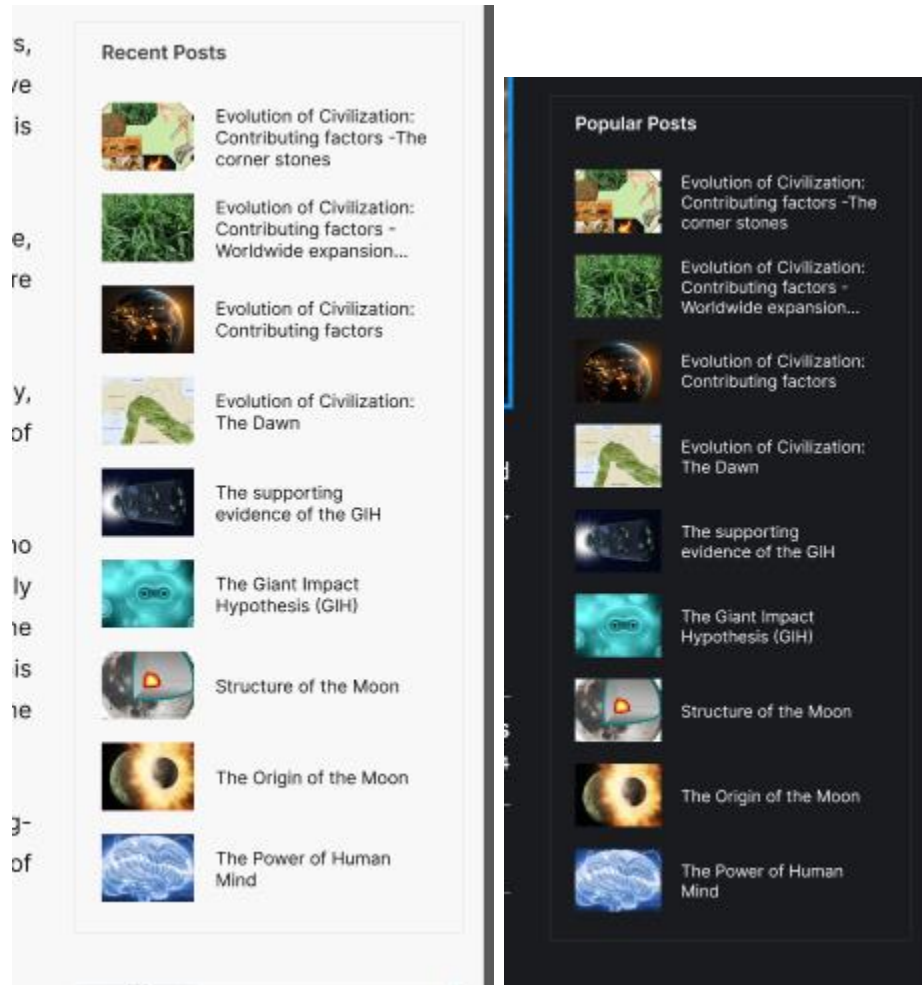

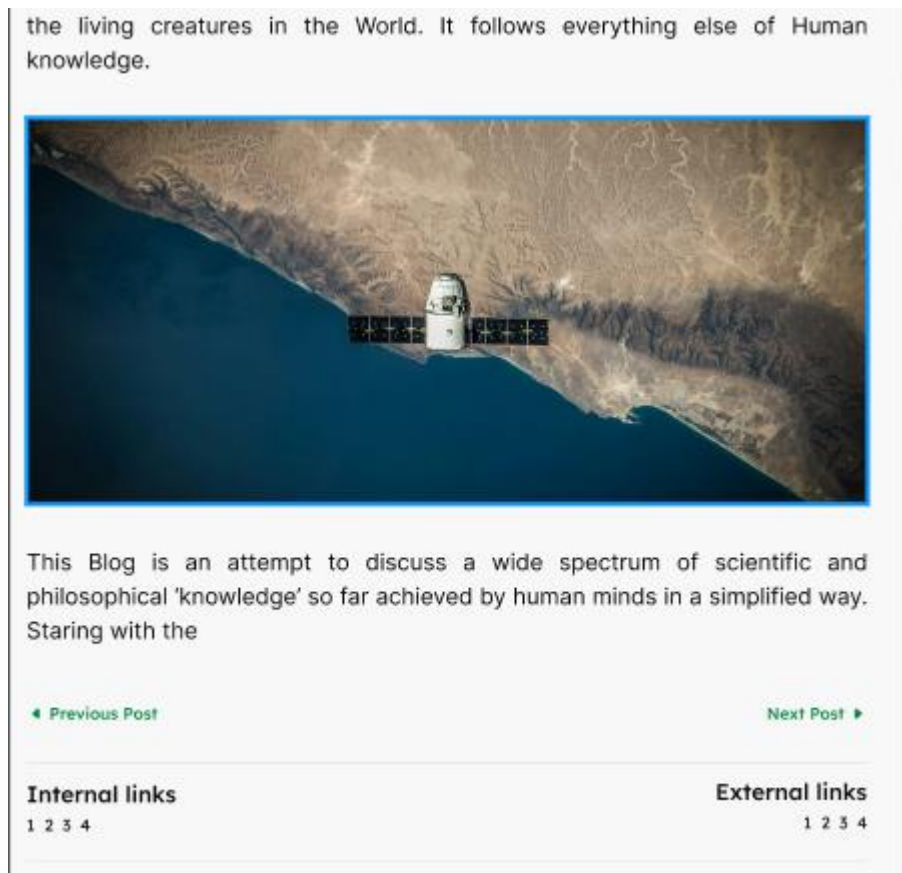
The Admin should choose what to be shown in Related write-ups for each of the blog posts and category page. Same goes for “Popular among readers”.



Blog content page / Individual content page

Dynamic features –

1. Title, subtitle, thumbnail image, main writing of the blog.
2. Admin may want to post a long series of a single topic by dividing it to some small blog. In that case, he has to link the blog with an existing/already published blog. Previous post, Next Post may navigate to those blogs.
3. Internal links should be added while creating a blog. Internal Links will show all the existing/already published blogs and admin will choose one or more posts to show them in the Internal Posts option.
4. External links should be added while creating a blog. External Links will show some small notes where complex topics will be explained shortly.



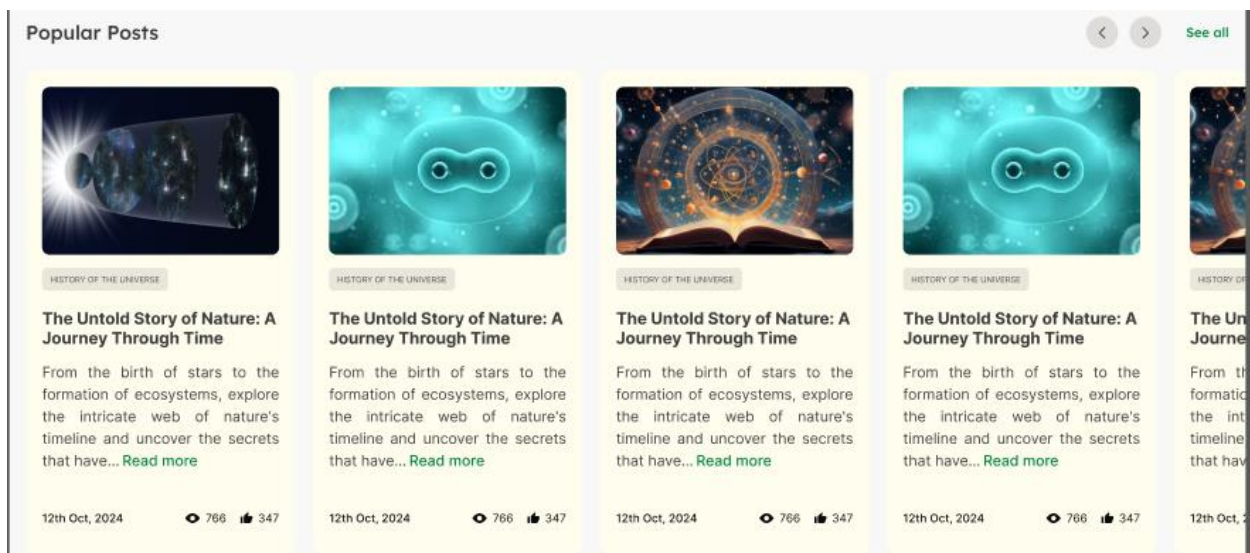
5. Like & Comments control.

- Admin should have access to edit, delete, unpublished the blog.

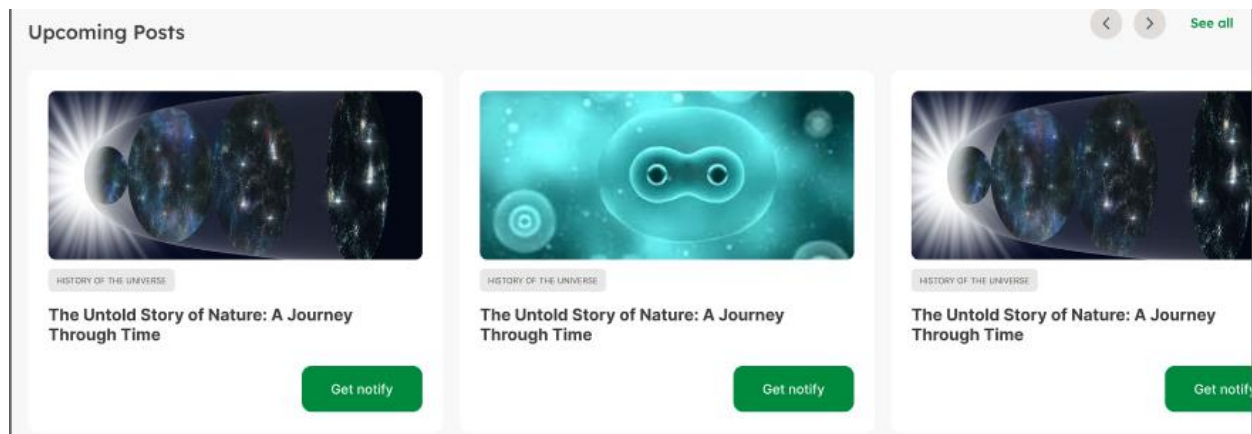
Homepage Posts sections

Dynamic features –

- Popular posts - Admin should choose among the existing/published posts to show on this section. Latest 5 will be shown on the homepage and rest of the popular posts will be shown on a separate page by See all click.



- Upcoming posts – Admin will create upcoming posts with a Title and a thumbnail image. By clicking the button attached, which is Get Notify, visitor will see the modal of registration/sign-up with email and will be notified when this particular blog will be published.
